Captains are reminded of the following:

All entries must be made online by the deadline. No late entries will be accepted. No faxed, emailed or telephoned entries will be accepted. No new entries on the day will be accepted. Captains are strongly advised to enter reserve teams and substitute athletes.

Meal Tickets: All meal tickets must be ordered online via the IUAA online entries system and paid for by the deadline, as the IUAA has to give numbers and payment to the venue. No cash will be handled on the day. Payment for meal tickets will be by invoice, issued on Monday 4th. Payment will be by bank transfer to the Irish Universities Athletics Association bank account Referencing your College name. BIC/IBAN will be on the invoice.

Captains will receive their meal tickets at the Captains meeting provided payment has been received in Advance.

- Athletes must be eligible for IUAA competition as defined in 6.2.1 & 8.2 of the IUAA constitution.
- One Year Down (OYD) athletes can only compete in the season immediately following the academic year in which they last held a valid student card. Athletes can't compete as a OYD during a year off books.
- Check-in opens at 11.00am and <u>closes 45 minutes prior to the start</u> of each race, so as to allow the races to start on time. All athletes are encouraged to check-in early so as to avoid a last minute rush.
